

## Catamount By Deb Heatherly

### This class will teach students to use the:

- Creative Grids® CGRDH1- Cat's Cradle Tool

Students may purchase the cat's cradle tool from their local quilt shop or, from my web site [www.debscatsnquilts.com](http://www.debscatsnquilts.com) before the class. I will also have 3 with me to share in class but having your own will keep you from having to wait.

The Catamount (Grids Girls Block Party # 7) handout will be provided to students taking this class at no charge. No additional pattern needed.



### Please bring to class:

Sewing machine with power cord and foot control

Thread and bobbin

Rotary cutter with fresh blade

Small cutting mat

Straight pins, scissors, seam ripper, and anything else you normally use to sew

Small basic ruler (6 x 12)

Ruler to square half square triangles (Suggested: Creative Grids® CGR 4, Stripology Mini, or Perfect 5)

Mechanical pencil

Iron and small ironing surface

Best Press, Magic Sizing, or whatever you prefer to use when pressing

\*Extension cord and power strip unless provided by venue.

### Our goal in this class is to:

- To fully understand how to use the cat's cradle tool.
- To complete at least (1) Catamount block.

### Deb will also discuss and demonstrate:

- Pressing tips and techniques.
- How color selection and placement will change the look of your cat's cradle block.
- Squaring the half square triangles using the optional tools mentioned above.

**Please pre-cut for at least 1 block (column 1 on cutting chart) before class and place individual cuts in a zip loc labeled with size and any other pertinent information so that you can easily find the pieces you need in class.**

## Grids Girls Block Party # 7 - Catamount 12" Finished block

This pattern uses the Creative Grids® Cat's Cradle Tool.

Fabric	Cutting for one block	Cutting for quilt 63" x 77"
<b>White</b>	<p>(4) 3" squares for corners.</p> <p>Cut (4) 3 ½" squares for HST.</p> <p>Cut (4) 2" x 3" rectangles for cat's cradle.</p>	<p>Cut (5) 3" strips WOF. Sub-cut (80) 2 ½" squares for corners.</p> <p>Cut (7) 3 ½" strips WOF. Sub-cut into (80) 3 ½" squares for HST.</p> <p>Cut (4) 3" strips WOF. Sub-cut (80) 2" x 3" rectangles for cat's cradle.</p>
<b>Black</b>	<p>Cut (4) 2" squares for cat's cradle.</p> <p>Cut (1) 2 ½" square for cornerstone.</p> <p>Cut (2) 3 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles for cat's cradle.</p>	<p>Cut (4) 2" strips WOF. Sub-cut (80) 2" squares for cat's cradle.</p> <p>Cut (2) 2 ½" strips WOF. Sub-cut into (32) 2 ½" cornerstones.</p> <p>Cut (4) 4 ½" strips WOF. Sub-cut (40) 3 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles for cat's cradle.</p>
<b>Gray</b>	<p>Cut (4) 2 ½" x 5 ½" rectangle for sashing.</p>	<p>Cut (23) 2 ½" strips WOF. Sub-cut (31) 2 ½" x 12 ½" for quilt sashing and (80) 2 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles for block sashing.</p> <p>Cut (7) 1 ½" strips WOF for inner border.</p>
<b>Teal, purple, green, and mauve</b>	<p><b>From a single color:</b> Cut (4) 3 ½" squares from a single color for HST.</p>	<p><b>From each color cut:</b> Cut (2) 3 ½" strips WOF. Sub-cut (20) 3 ½" squares for HST.</p>
<b>Outer border</b>	N/A	Cut (8) 4" strips WOF.

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
