

Supply List for Small Studies

Sewing Machine and accessories (power cord, foot pedal)

¼" piecing foot for your machine

Rotary cutter with a new blade

Cutting mat (18" x 24" or 12" x 18")

A clear acrylic ruler (6" x 24" and/or 6" x 12") – most students do well with just the 6" x 12" ruler

Basic sewing kit (scissors, seam ripper, straight pins)

Thread in a neutral cotton

Fabric – I like to work with solid-colored 100% cotton fabrics, but really any cotton fabric that “reads” solid or has a slight print would work as well. Large scale prints won’t highlight this technique but narrow striped fabrics or small abstract prints look quite interesting mixed with the solid fabrics. Don’t forget to include lights and darks in your fabric selection.

As far as amount of fabric goes, 1/8 of a yard cuts of a variety of fabrics would be plenty. Scraps work great as well! Strips, chunks and odd-shaped pieces can all play!

If you would like more direction, bring at least 10-12 different fabrics that make you happy of at least 1/8 of a yard. More fabric is always fine 😊.
