Workshop supply list

Please choose which version you wish to make and select your fabrics accordingly. In class, we will work on making several New York Beauty blocks and several alternate blocks.

GENERAL SUPPLIES

Bernina sewing machines provided by “The Cotton Cupboard Quilt Shop”

Neutral color thread on top and in the bobbin.

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade, personal size cutting mat

9-1/2” square ruler (I suggest Omnigrd or Creative Grids)

Pigma Brush tip or Chisel tip pen

Scissors, pins, small trash bag, baggie for scraps to make optional miniature version

Caramels or Snickerdoodles might be nice!

FABRICS:

Pre-Cut per the cutting chart on page (2) and bagged so that you can easily identify the pieces.

For class purposes you don't need to bring fabrics for the whole quilt unless you would like to have your choices with you. We will not get to the borders in class.

Minimum needed for class would be:

Grey - (6) 9” squares and 5-6 strips in various increments

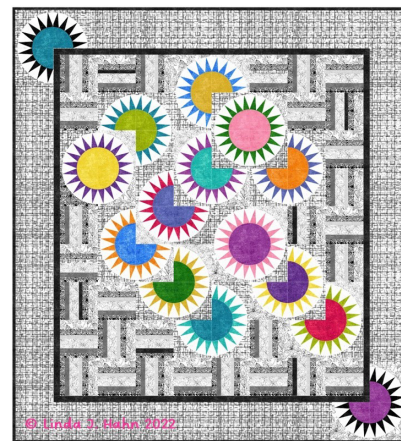
Pie Shape colors - (3) sets of (4) 4-1/2” squares of same color

Spires - (Single color— (60) 2-1/2” x 3-1/2” rectangles

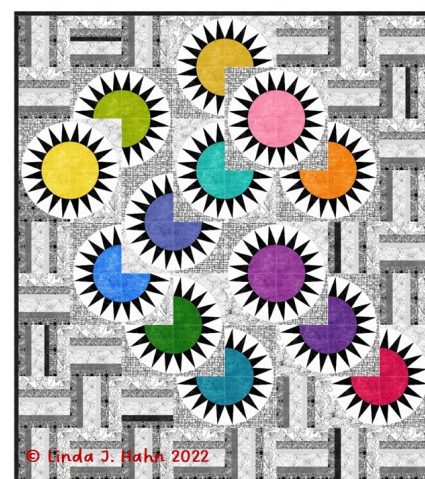
OR - (Multi color - (3) sets of (20) 2-1/2” x 3-1/2” rectangles of the same color

White - (72) 3” x 4” rectangles

Alternate blocks	Minimum of 15-16 "long" quarters	From each 1/4 yard cut (2) 9" squares FIRST. Pin together and set aside.			
Asst. small print greys, black & whites	(9" x WOF) or use your scraps***	From remainder of strip cut a variety of different strip sizes: 1-1/4", 1-1/2", 2" and 2-1/4". These will be randomly selected and pieced together for alternate blocks.			
Binding	Your Choice of fabric	1/2 yard - your choice of fabric			

***You need a total of (43) 9" squares for No Border version and (49) for the With Border version. ** You will get (2)

background pieces from each 9" square**
