



403 – Piecing a Picture Quilt (Landscape, Daylily or Cat) with Betsy Habich

Supply Sheet

- ✓ Sewing machine
- ✓ Neutral color thread, plus threads listed below under pattern
- ✓ Size 12 sharp needles

For freezer paper templates:

- ✓ Freezer paper (grocery store near wax paper)
- ✓ Transparent tape (Scotch Magic tape, matte)
- ✓ Blue painters' tape or another re-positionable

adhesive

- ✓ Ultra-Fine Point Sharpie (must be Ultra Fine Point)
- ✓ Highlighter in 3-4 colors

For cutting and marking fabric:

- ✓ Pigma Micron pens (fine point) or color pencils & sharpener in colors that will be visible on the wrong side of your fabric
- ✓ Fine pins
- ✓ Paper and fabric scissors
- ✓ Tackable surface about 20" x 30" (such as Foam-Core from office supply store, or design wall)

Fabric Suggestions for each pattern:

Note on quantity: The finished pieces are only about 12" x 18", so you do not need a lot of any one fabric.

Daylily (check our pictures of daylilies on the web for the many color combinations out there):

- Daylily center (throat): intense orange, yellow, or yellow-green.
- Daylily petals: maroon, red, orange, peach, yellow, or a combination of these
- Daylily leaves: medium to dark green (to stand out from the background)
- Background foliage: fabric that suggests leaves, particularly long, strappy daylily leaves
- Sky: medium to light blue
- Pistils & stamen: these will be either embroidered, couched, or stitched using yellow, orange, or yellow-green thread.

Miss Lucy Cat:

Pattern is designed so you can make Miss Lucy into a tuxedo cat or not as you wish!

- Cat eyes: very small pieces of black, white and either yellow, green or possibly green/blue
- Cat nose and inside of ears: pale pink (unless your cat has a brick or black nose!)
- Cat body: Fur colored fabric. If you have fabric that has long curving lines, use it!
- Lower background: fabric that suggests either grass or ground
- Upper background: fabric that suggests either sky or foliage, depending on where you want your cat sitting
- If you want to add whiskers, these can be stitched, embroidered, or couched in white or (if you are making a black kitty, black)

Jordan Pond (Landscape):

It's Autumn in the sample, but with the right fabric choices, it can be any season!

- Sky: Light blue (or possibly light gray if you want it to be Winter)
- Pond: A medium-light blue (or white if you want it to be Winter and the pond is frozen)
- Trees: Light green (Spring), medium green (Summer), yellow-orange-red (Fall) or brown and white (Winter)
- Rocks: Small amount of brown or gray
- The Bubbles (two hills in the background): one hill is behind the other. They should be similar colors, with the further away hill a bit grayer. For instance, Spring/Summer: closer hill medium green & further hill, gray green. For Fall, brown & gray-brown. For Winter, off-white and light gray.
- If you are portraying Spring or Summer or Fall, and would like to add pond grass around the foreground rocks, it can be machine stitched or embroidered using a light green (Spring), green (Summer) or light brown (Fall) thread.
