



405 – Needleturn Applique and Beyond with Dawn Heese

The yardage below is for the entire quilt.

4 yards cream print for background and outer border
1-yard navy stripe for eagle, inner border, and bias binding,
1/2-yard navy print for stars, inner border
1 1/2 yards total assorted red prints for stars and flowers
3 yards total assorted green prints for leaves, stems
1/8-yard total assorted pink prints for flowers
4 1/2 yards backing fabric
78" x 78" piece of batting

If you only want to make one block for the class, you will need a 22 1/2" square of cream background fabric, medium size scraps of red, pink and green prints. At least one fat quarter size piece of green for bias stems.

Other supplies:

Sharpie

Scissors (for paper cutting also)

Freezer paper

Chalk pencil

Applique pens

Size 11 milliner's needle

Aurifil 80 wt. thread in colors to match applique or #2370 neutral

Clover 3/8" bias tape maker

Clover 1/2" bias tape maker

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler for squaring large blocks and cutting bias strips.

Vinyl for overlays will be provided.
