Unlock your creativity in our engaging seven-hour class as you learn to design stunning "Celtic"-style quilt blocks and master the art of creating bias stems with my innovative folding and cutting technique. You will have the opportunity to design two unique blocks and will leave the class with one or more blocks fully basted and ready for applique with your preferred method. You will also learn the ins and outs of invisible machine applique for flawless results!

SUPPLY LIST	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>FABRICS:</b>
	<i>For the two blocks we will work on in class, cut two 18-19" squares for the block backing. These two squares need to be pressed with spray sizing <u>before</u> class. I suggest spray sizing twice so the fabric is quite stiff for the machine applique process.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>	½ yards of 3 to 4 coordinating fabrics for your bias stem elements – I recommend that you do not use solid fabrics. Using a stripe as one of your fabrics is especially fun for this part of the project.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fat quarter of 1 to 2 fabrics for the inset piece. These fabrics should accent colors to coordinate with the fabrics
SUPPLIES:	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rotary cutter, 45mm or 60mm size
<input type="checkbox"/>	Rotary mat: Mat 18" x 24" recommended
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ruler – 6"x24", or 6½" or 8½" wide
<input type="checkbox"/>	Basic construction thread
<input type="checkbox"/>	Invisible thread – I recommend invisible thread from Sulky or Superior Threads
<input type="checkbox"/>	New Microtex size 70 needle
<input type="checkbox"/>	Markers or colored pencils in 3 or 4 colors – or other bold tip markers in colors that can coordinate with your chosen stem fabrics and color pencils to help with creating your design.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sharp, small scissors that will cut through at least 4 layers of fabric easily.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Water-soluble, acid-free glue stick – the UHU brand is Nancy's recommended brand. These will be available for purchase at the class for \$1.50 each.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Roxanne Baste-It-Glue
<input type="checkbox"/>	Seam Guilds from Guildlines4Quilters - These are the perfect tools for making the ideal scant ¼" seam allowance. Nancy will bring some for sale during class, as these can be hard to find.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Bias Stem Bars –Clover Loop Pressing Bars or Collins Bias Bars. The Collins bars are no longer available for purchase, but you may already have them in your quilting tool box.
