**SUPPLY LIST**

**FABRICS:**

- A variety of fabrics, scraps, strips, fat quarters, or eighths. Bring a variety of fabrics that have a nice contrast. A total equivalent of 2 yards would make a small crib quilt.
- 2 yards good quality muslin (or an ugly fabric from your stash that you don't like anyway) cut into 9" square blocks.

**SUPPLIES:**

- Sewing Machine – you don't need a “fancy” machine for this technique, so feel free to bring your “travel” machine.
- Rotary cutter, 45mm or 60mm size
- Rotary mat: Mat 18" x 24" recommended.
- Ruler – 6"x24", or 6½" or 8½" wide
- 100% Cotton 50 wt. cotton thread for piecing
- New MicroTex 70 needle for piecing.
- Spray Sizing
