

Free motion Quilting - steps to success :

Discover the magic of free-motion quilting. We will start with putting pens to paper to learn how to combine basic shapes to create a variety of interesting quilting designs. Once you are comfortable with drawing the shapes on paper, we will put the feed dogs down and learn how to translate these designs onto fabric using pre-made quilt sandwiches. You will have the opportunity to try lots of different designs to find your personal favorites in this relaxed, no-criticism-allowed setting. You will leave with a variety of samples to practice at home and the confidence to do so.

Kit (\$16) includes sewing machine thread, needle, safety pins and handout

Supply list

Materials: (enthusiastic stitchers might want to bring more!)

14, 10" squares solid color fabric

2, 10" square pieced blocks of any design (or 2 more solid squares)

8, 10" squares low loft cotton batting

Equipment:

scissors

drawing paper (printer paper works well)

Fine tip marker e.g. micron pen or ultra-fine Sharpie

paper and pen for notes

Optional:

Kwik Klip

Sewing machine required with suitable free motion foot
